

Items Unauthorized to be Purchased with Central APFs

Attachment 6 of AFI 34-270 lists materials that may not be purchased with library central APFs due to the availability through other sources:

- **Non-mission support publications & materials for dayrooms, lodging, air terminals, VIP aircraft, distinguished visitor lounges, recreation centers, family support centers, youth activity facilities, hospital and clinic waiting rooms, and the like.**
- **Training aids and multiple copies of materials for use in military and civilian education programs, family support centers, and religious activities (Refer to AFI 36-2306; AF 52-101; and AFMAN 23-110, v. 2 Pt. 2)**
- **Promotion fitness exams (PFE) and specialty knowledge test (SKT) guides (AFI 36-2605)**
- **Visual information products such as DVDs, video cassettes, films, etc.**
- **Computer application software programs for offices, organizations, and agencies supported by AFLIS which are not information products.**
